(1) The dealer shall: (a) Assure that shellstock is: (i) Alive; <b>[K]</b> (ii) Reasonably free of sediment <b>[O]</b> ; and (iii) Culled; <b>[K]</b> (2) The dealer shall inspect incoming shipments and shall reject dead or inadequately protected shellstock; <b>[K]</b> (3) A dealer <del>whose activity consists of trucks or docking facilities only</del> shall: (a) Have a permanent business address at which records are maintained and inspections can be performed <u>in a timely fashion</u> ; and <b>[K]</b> (b) Not repack <u>shellstock or be the original shipper of shellstock received from a harvester if their facility consists of trucks or docking facilities only.</u> <b>[K]</b>
