<b>Charge 1:</b>	The Subcommittee will use the <i>Vv</i> Illness Criteria Form adopted in 2007 as a part of Proposal 05-101 to screen cases to determine the appropriateness of inclusion into the database used for illness reduction calculations.		
<b>Findings:</b>	The Subcommittee used the Criteria Form to screen all cases.		
<b>Conclusions:</b>	The Criteria Form worked well for this use.		
<b>Recommendations:</b>	The Criteria Form continue to be used.		
<b>Charge 2:</b>	In addition, to ensure uniformity, the form shall be used by the Subcommittee for screening 2007-2008 cases and that cases from the baseline will be screened using the same form.		
<b>Findings:</b>	The Subcommittee used the Criteria Form to screen the 2007 and 2008 cases.		
<b>Conclusions:</b>	The form worked well and ensured uniformity in the review of cases.		
<b>Recommendations:</b>	The form continue to be used.		
<b>Additional Information:</b>	The subcommittee found that 17 cases in 2007 met the criteria and 13 cases met the criteria for 2008. After adjusting for population changes, the illness rate reduction was calculated to be 35.2% from the baseline period. Calculations and case information is attached.
