<b>Text of Proposal/ Requested Action</b>	Change current definitions and add new definitions as listed below and renumber Section II. Model Ordinance B. Definitions of Terms section appropriately.
	(16) <del>Commingle or Commingling means the act of combining different lots of shellstock or shucked shellfish.</del>
	(90) Reshipper (RS) means a person who purchases <del>shucked shellfish or shellstock</del> from dealers and sells the product without repacking or relabeling to other dealers, wholesalers, or retailers.
	(102) Shellstock Shipper (SS) means a dealer who grows, harvests, buys, or repacks and sells shellstock. They are not authorized to shuck shellfish nor to repack shucked shellfish. A shellstock shipper may also <u>buy, repack, and sell in-shell product as well as</u> ship shucked shellfish.
	NEW <u>In-shell product packing means the process of placing in-shell product into containers for introduction into commerce.</u>
	NEW <u>Lot of in-shell product means a single type of container of in-shell product of no more than one day's harvest from a single defined growing area.</u>
	NEW <u>Repacking in-shell product means the practice of removing in-shell product from containers and placing it into other containers.</u>
<b>Public Health Significance:</b>	This proposal is one of several that are part of an effort to incorporate the concept of in-shell product throughout the Model Ordinance.
