The ISSC Regions shall be:</p> <p><u>Region 1 - Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Maryland, Delaware, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia</u></p> <p><u>Region 2 - Florida, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Texas</u></p> <p><u>Region 3 - Alaska, Washington, Oregon, California, Hawaii</u></p>
Public Health Significance:	The region changes submitted in this proposal reflect the true regions of the shellfisheries the U.S. This distribution of regional representation will be more accurate and fair as this conference currently exists.
