**Charges**

**Charge 1: Proposal 17-225: Clarification of Surf Clams and Ocean Quahogs Exemption from Time/Temperature Requirements.**

**Findings/Conclusions:**

A study was developed to address concerns of this proposal but the data is not yet available due to various reasons. Once the data is available, it will need to be reviewed by the Laboratory Committee. Action on the proposal cannot be completed until the study results and Laboratory Committee review are complete.

**Recommendations:**

The Committee recommends Proposal 17-225 be referred to an appropriate committee as determined by the conference chair.

**Charge 2: Proposal 19-220: Shipping Temperatures**

**Findings/Conclusions:**

Changing the wording to “maintained” would require constant monitoring. Pre-chilled trucks have chilled walls that help quickly lower temperatures when doors are opened and closed.

**Recommendations:**

The Committee recommends no action on Proposal 19-220. Rationale: This is adequately addressed in the Model Ordinance.

**Charge 3: Proposal 19-231: Addition of shipping CCP.**

**Findings/Conclusions:**

The proposed language would transfer HACCP responsibilities from the dealer to the shipper. There is no means to track the shipment that would guarantee shellfish has been held at an adequate temperature.

**Recommendations:**

The Committee recommends no action on Proposal 19-231. Rationale : This is adequately addressed in the Model Ordinance.
