## SEA WIN, INC. RECALLS FROZEN HALF SHELL OYSTERS BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE HEALTH RISK

Sea Win, Inc. of Los Angeles, CA is initiating a recall on 650 cases of Frozen Half Shell Oysters, specifically KR 7 SP with harvest dates of 01/30/2024 and 02/04/2024 due to the oysters possibly being affected by Norovirus. Consumption of this product may include diarrhea, stomach cramps, nausea, vomiting, fever, and chills. Symptoms usually appear 12 hours after eating contaminated shellfish, and can last two days.

Frozen Half Shell Oysters were distributed specifically in the city of Los Angeles and Irvine, California to other wholesale distributors.

The Frozen Half Shell Oysters were packed in a white corrugated box with the label stating Frozen Half Shell Oysters, Product of Korea, Pack 144 counts, with a shellfish tag harvest dates of 01/30/24 and 02/04/24.

The recall was the result of California Department of Public Health's notification of multiple illnesses related to the consumption of the 650 cases of Frozen Half Shell Oysters, specifically KR 7 SP harvest dates of 01/30/2024 and 02/04/2024.

Consumers who have purchased Frozen Half Shell Oysters, specifically KR 7 SP harvest dates of 01/30/2024 and 02/04/2024 are urged to return them to the place of purchase for a full refund.
