Voluntary Recall of Frozen Oysters on the ½ shell

To Whom It May Concern;

On December 26th, 2027, we received notice of an illness outbreak from the California Department of Public Health. We were notified that product we had purchased from one of our vendors had linked reports of causing illness when consumed. The Product in question was Frozen oysters packed in the KPR on 03/24/2024, under ICSS List # KR-15-SP.

Golden State Seafood has decided as a precautionary measure to recall all product that has not been used for consumption to ensure public safety.

As part of our HACCP Plan and SQF Recall Policy, we will ensure that all product still available for return will be picked up with immediate effect and continuous monitoring of this current recall as well as full transparency with manners regarding any further notices of illness.
