

SHELLFISH RECALL ALERT NOTICE

AFFECTED PRODUCT: Live Shellstock Oysters (Lot 6/24/26 AGAI 121)

AFFECTED STATE: Texas

ALERT - IMMEDIATE ACTION IS REQUIRED

This is a Recall Alert Notice from the State of Maine. The State of Maine is supporting a recall of shellstock oysters due to harvest during a rainfall closure associated with limited purpose aquaculture site AGAI 121 in the Yarmouth, Maine harvest area. The grower initiated a voluntary recall prior to contacting Maine Department of Marine Resources and was able to reclaim all product sold to Harbor Fish (233 SS) from Portland, Maine and 10-100 count bags from Upstream Trucking (4 SS) also in Portland, Maine. Upstream Trucking has contacted their customer who received 10-100 count bags of live shellstock oysters identified with **Lot 6/24/26 AGAI 121** and instructed them to follow their recall protocols. While this is a voluntary recall, immediate action is required.

Receiving State IMMEDIATE Actions

The identified states above are documented to have received affected recalled shellfish with Lot 6/24/26 AGAI 121. Receiving states must take the following immediate actions:

1. Verify companies in your state have received a recall notice from Upstream Trucking.
2. Verify companies in your state have ceased sale, service, and distribution of the affected product.
3. Verify disposal of all affected product (containers or prepped for service) which remain in inventory.
4. Verify downstream customers who may have received affected product have been alerted.
5. Report recall updates to the producing Authority (Maine).

This recall is due to oysters harvested from limited purpose aquaculture site AGAI 121 in Yarmouth, Maine during a rainfall-related closure. While this recall is voluntary, it is necessary to protect public health. No illnesses have been reported in association with this recall.
