Notice of Shellfish Reopening

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) has reopened shellfish harvesting areas from the **Charleston Harbor** south to the **North Edisto River** that were previously closed on the morning of February 27, 2018, due to a large sewer line breach near the headwaters of the Stono River. The harvest areas that have reopened are C166, C168, C172, C173, C188, C191, C192, C195, C197, C198, C199, C200, C202, C204, C207, C209, C210, C215, C216, C227, M156, M157, M166, M168, M168L, M198A, M206, M211 AND M212.
