

Pre-Proposal Process

Applicant
Method Developer or
Lab Proposing SLV Work

Pre-Proposal
Letter of Intent sent to the ISSC
Executive Office

LMRC makes recommendations to Task
Force I or Executive Board based on:

- ISSC interest or need for the proposed method
- Goodness of fit of LMRC for this review
- Readiness of the proposed method and its use for SLV

Screening Process

ISSC Executive Board or Voting
Delegates to invite applicant for full SLV
and assign a liaison person from LMRC

ISSC Executive Office receives SLV
application and Q/C checklist items,
establishes a submission date, and
distributes to the LMRC

LMRC has six (6) months to determine
whether the application is complete and
Q/A checklist items are attached or to
request additional information or
analysis with timelines.

Approval Process

Complete application proposal for
laboratory method submitted to the
LMRC by ISSC Executive Director.

LMRC has six (6) months to review SLV
application and checklist, document
findings, and cite specific deficiencies in
the method, SLV, or checklist

LMRC makes recommendations to Task
Force I or Executive Board on approval
of method and checklist
