REOPENING OF MOLLUSCAN SHELLFISH WATERS IN LOUISIANA

Pursuant to the provisions of LSA R.S. 40:5.3 as amended and re-enacted by Act 1 of the First Regular Legislative Session of 1988, and R.S. 40:5, the Precautionary Closure Order of molluscan shellfish waters in Louisiana effective dated October 25, 2010 is hereby rescinded.

All waters centered near Bay Jimmy, Bay Batiste, & Wilkinson Bay except within 100 yards of any shoreline will revert back to its current May-August seasonal classification status. These two small closures are located in the Molluscan Shellfish Harvest Area 12.

This order effective one half hour before official sunrise, August 4, 2014.
